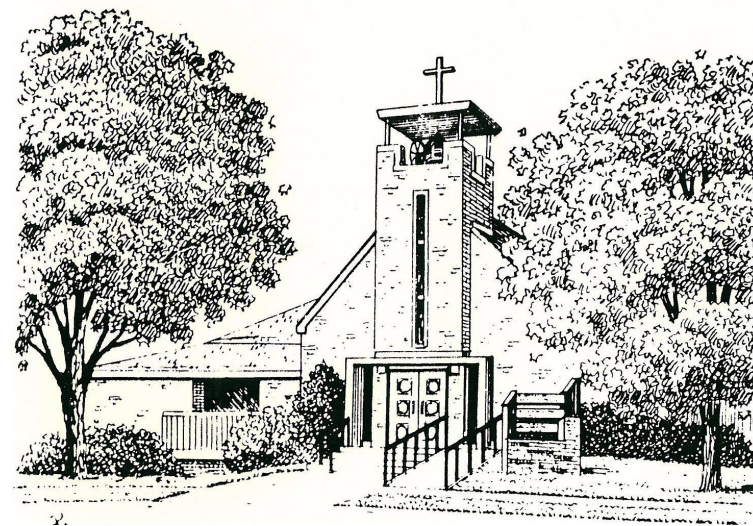
Prayer Requests:
