Prayer Requests:

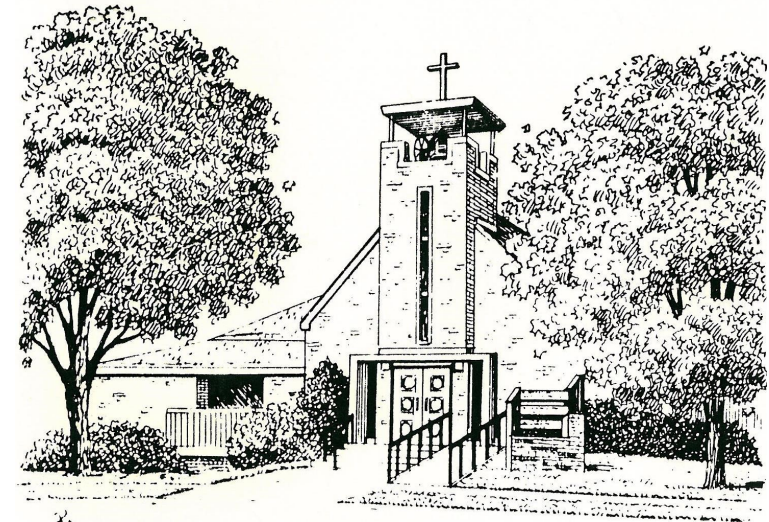
